Directors' Report pursuant to Listing Rule 5.75.2

For the six-months ended 31 December 2014

The Directors present their report in accordance with the requirements of MFSA Listing Rule 5.74. This report, which shall be read in conjunction with the Condensed Consolidated Interim Financial Statements for the six months ended 31 December 2014, including the Notes thereto, forms part of the Half-Yearly Report of Loqus Holdings p.l.c., drawn up in terms of the requirements of Listing Rules 5.74 to 5.75.

Principal Activities

The Company holds investments in subsidiaries engaged in the provision of fleet management, back-office processing, and ICT solutions.

The Group registered a turnover of €1,805,804 (2013: €1,694,637) over the six months ended 31 December 2014. A loss before tax of €117,556 (2013: Loss before tax of €135,207) was reported by the Group. The Group registered another marked improvement of 44% in EBITDA. Tight cost control and success in new revenue sources have improved profit to revenue ratios across all business units. This also translated in an increase in net cash-flow from operating activities which allowed the Group to increase investment in research and development, since this will ultimately give the required cutting-edge in the business. The period July to December 2014 was another period of progress in the Group's journey to deliver sustainable growth, with a further decrease in loss for the period of 13%.

The Group has placed all its sellable fleet management related assets and business into a new subsidiary called Loqus Fleet Limited. Loqus Fleet successfully launched a number of new projects and as importantly the renewal and further development of existing customers. Artoni in Italy renewed their contract with Loqus and moved to our new HTML5 based dispatching platform and the Loqus Fleet further enhanced on the tracking system for the municipal police of Rome. Geopost/DPD, one of the most important delivery companies in the UK, have continued to grow their engagement with us with a number of new initiatives as we constantly expand our flagship route, network & organisational optimisation tools. The Group has also recently been awarded a tender for the procurement and installation of traceability equipment for the Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture which continues to consolidate our dominance in the local market when it comes to Vessel Monitoring Systems for the public sector. Apart from Fisheries, the Group has major systems at the Government Property Division, Transport Malta, Malta Industrial Parks, Land Registry, Department of Local

Government & Malta Information Technology Agency (MITA), all through our newly acquired Loqus Public Sector.

Although an improvement in our cash generation from operations has been reported, cash flow will continue to be a challenge. Even though Loqus has encountered an extremely difficult period in terms of cash flow, the Group has, by August 2014, repaid in full all bank facilities. This was done by ensuring that all relevant loans and excess facilities were repaid on time despite the poor cash flow position.

Way forward

Our aim is to clarify the performance of our Fleet Management business which will in turn allow the Group to attract and retain strategic investors and personnel. Our ability to compete internationally depends on our ability to improving our products faster than our competitors, anticipating industry requirements, developing and launching new products and platforms while pricing our products competitively by constantly reducing setup and monthly costs. Our agenda for the next two years is to merge our products into a continuous range of Fleet Management products covering Tracking, Driver Behaviour, Mobile Workforce Management, Field Service Management, Scheduling, Dispatch and Optimisation. These products will be cloud based and on open web systems to provide the lowest cost, high quality solutions that we are capable of providing.

Overall, the financial period under review shows another marked improvement over the prior year. We hope that the Group's financial situation will soon start to reflect more tangibly our confidence in our products and services.

Notes to the Condensed Consolidated Interim Financial Statements

For the six-months ended 31 December 2014

Reporting entity

Loqus Holdings p.l.c. ("the Company"), is a limited liability company incorporated in Malta on the 23rd day of October of the year 2000. The condensed consolidated interim financial statements of the Group as at and for the six months ended 31st December 2014 comprise the Company and its subsidiaries (together referred to as the "Group") and the Group's interests in an associated company.

Basis of preparation and statement of compliance

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared on a historical cost basis. The condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Companies Act, Cap. 386 of the Laws of Malta accounting standards adopted for use in the EU for interim financial statements (EU adopted IAS 34 *Interim Financial Reporting*).

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been extracted from the unaudited and unreviewed group management accounts for the six months ended 31st December 2014.

The interim financial statements do not include all of the information required for full annual financial statements, and should be read in conjunction with the financial statements of Loqus Holdings p.l.c. as at and for the year ended 30th June 2014.

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved by the Board of Directors on 23rd February 2015.

Going concern

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared on a going concern basis which assumes that the Group will continue in existence for the foreseeable future. The Directors have reasonable expectation that the Group has adequate resources to improve its liquidity and to take the necessary decisions to continue its operations in the foreseeable future.

The consolidated financial statements of the Group as at and for the period ended 30th June 2014 are available upon request from the Company's registered office at SUB008A, Industrial Estate, San Gwann, Malta.

Significant accounting policies

The accounting policies applied by the Group in these condensed consolidated interim financial statements are the same as those applied by the Group in its financial statements as at and for the year ended 30th June 2014.

Segment information

For management purposes, the group is organised into business units based on their products and services as follows:

- Fleet management Vehicle and Marine Tracking Systems and On the Move Logistics Solutions including tailor made solutions as well as off the shelf packages. This department previously also incorporated products and services which are now classified within Original Equipment Manufacturers in view of the incorporation of Logus Fleet Limited.
- Original Equipment Manufacturers This includes Fleet Management contracts which the group holds with resellers under their own name and branding.
- Back-office processing variety of high level, off site services to support entities.
- Projects assist clients in selecting appropriate ICT solutions and in implementing them.

Management monitors revenue and directly attributable costs of its business units separately for the purpose of making decision about resource allocation and performance assessment. Segment performance is evaluated based on operating profit or loss and is measured consistently with operating profit and loss in the consolidated financial statements. Corporate expenses are allocated based on the segmental revenues. However, the Group assets and liabilities are managed on a Group basis and are not allocated to operating segments.
